Topic 1: New structure for education activities (presented by Steffi Knorn)

- The task force leaded by Lucy Pao has proposed to established a new executive committee (that is able to do things). The chair will be a nonvoting member of the IFAC Council.
- TC 9.4 will still exist. It is no longer called EdCom (Education Committee) as the name can cause some confusion.
- TC Vice Chairs (VC) for education should enhance activities for education
- The idea is that everything will be brought to the attention of the IFAC community.
- The relationship with the TC VCs is not formalised, but there will be a known list of contact people within when there is something relevant to communicate to all TCs.

- Repository for control resources: coordinated by Anthony Rossiter with help of John Hedengren, Brian Douglas (resourcium.org). The idea is to build a very simple website with links to the collected resources.
- Brian Douglas: resourcium.org was started with no cooperation, looking forward to some cooperation.
- Roadmap for control for societal challenges (working group coordinated by Anthony Rossiter), collaboration with IFAC and IEEE.
- Benchmark systems (Jose Luis Guzman): Taskforce on benchmarks for control to engage students. Currently difficult to maintain. Idea: Develop online platform, used by everybody.
 Smaller scale in Spain carried out. Review of benchmark system (Antonio).
